
**Bob Sullivan, President**



Emergency Response Systems



#### Join our Team of Volunteers!

Husband and wife couples desired in addition to Men of our Club!



Lifeline is a personal emergency response system that helps allow someone to live alone and have ready access to first responders who can help them. (Responders can be either the SCC Emergency Squad, the Hillsborough County Fire or Sheriff or even a relative or neighbor.) Annually, we have more than 500 instances of calls for help, and approximately 75 individuals can result in transport to the hospital.

A few good men (and couples) are needed to help the lifeline team with replacements, minor repairs and installations. Previous experience is helpful but not required. Lifeline will train you and you will only be asked to volunteer for one day a month.

At our August 16th Meeting!

Rear Admiral Wally Guthrie RADM, USN (Ret)

This talk will provide a non-technical overview of our Navy's nuclear-powered submarine force on the world's stage. It will describe the types and capabilities of our modern nuclear-powered submarine, discuss its role in national defense, and its relevance today in the highly technological world of undersea warfare. Come prepared to interact with questions!

Rear Admiral Guthrie had a career of more than 38-years in the U.S. Navy. He served on active duty, Navy Reserve, and as a civilian in the specialty of Submarine Warfare. He served on two diesel-electric submarines, the USS ASPRO (AGSS-309) and USS BUGARA (SS-331), and the nuclear-powered submarine USS ABRAHAM LINCOLN (SSBN-602) based in Holy Loch, Scotland. Rear Admiral Guthrie's last active duty assignment was as Deputy Director, U.S. Navy Reserve, Washington, DC. He retired in the civilian position of Superintendent of Schools, Defense Information School, Fort Meade, Maryland.
