He is the person who gave the order to clear the deck of the Aircraft Carrier USS Midway during the fall of Saigon to allow a Cessna piloted by South Vietnamese Air Force Major Baung to make his first carrier landing, thus saving the life of Major Baung and his family, who would have soon perished in the sea, but for Rear Admiral Chambers
